ORDER

THIS MATTER has come before the Court based upon various recent filings by *pro se* Plaintiff/Counter-Defendant, Judith Herskowitz ("Herskowitz"), and the Court having held a Status Conference on September 2, 2003, the Court finds as follows:

1. At the time of the Status Conference before the Court, Herskowitz had pending a Verified Motion to Strike as Sham the pleading and defenses of Defendant Susan Charney individually ("Charney"), etc. Since the Status Conference was held, apparently Herskowitz has filed an additional

Verified Motion for Constitutionally Mandated Inquiry into Whether the Jurisdictional Issues were Fully and Fairly Litigated and Finally Decided by the New York Court.


2. The Court has reviewed a sufficient amount of the file and determined that Herskowitz is raising issues which have already been determined by this Court. Particularly, the Court has reviewed the prior Orders of Judges Murray Goldman and Paul Siegel and has determined that these Orders were appealed to and affirmed by the Third District Court of Appeal.

3. Herskowitz is hereby directed and ordered not to file any further pleadings in any of the above-captioned cases without first obtaining leave of this Court.

4. All pending motions or applications for relief of any kind filed by Herskowitz are hereby stricken and for administrative purposes, this case is closed.

5. The Court does retain jurisdiction for the purposes of enforcement of the domestication proceedings brought by Charney.
