



the City of New York their shares of stock in North Jersey Trading Corporation; with leave to purge themselves of said contempt by payment of the fine of \$7,000.00, and by delivering the said shares of stock to the Sheriff of the City of New York as aforesaid, on or before the 4th day of February, 1993; and said order adjudging the said Petitioners, JUDITH HERSKOWITZ, [REDACTED], to be in contempt of court, having further provided that upon proof by affidavit of service as therein directed of a certified copy of said order dated January 19, 1993, upon said Petitioners, JUDITH HERSKOWITZ, [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and of their non-compliance therewith, an order of their commitment shall issue upon ex parte application without further notice; and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court from the aforesaid affirmation that a copy of the said order of the Hon. Harold Tompkins dated January 19, 1993, was duly personally served upon each of the said Petitioners, JUDITH HERSKOWITZ, [REDACTED], [REDACTED], on January 19, 1993; and that said Petitioners, JUDITH HERSKOWITZ, [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] have failed to purge themselves of said contempt in that they, and each of them, have failed to pay the fine of \$7,000.00 as aforesaid, and have further failed to deliver to the Sheriff of the City of New York, their shares of stock in North Jersey Trading Corporation,

NOW, on motion of Steven Delibert, Esq., attorney for

Additional Respondent-Judgment Creditor, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the said Petitioners, JUDITH HERSKOWITZ, [REDACTED], be and they hereby are declared guilty of contempt of Court in having disobeyed the Order of this Court dated September 18, 1992, in that they failed to deliver their shares of stock in North Jersey Trading Corporation to the Sheriff of the City of New York; and further, have failed to purge themselves of the contempt in that they failed to pay the fine of \$7,000.00, and failed to deliver their shares of stock in North Jersey Trading Corporation to the Sheriff of the City of New York; and it is further

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the said failure of the Petitioners, JUDITH HERSKOWITZ, [REDACTED] HERSKOWITZ, to comply with the order of this Court dated September 18, 1992, was calculated to and actually did defeat, impair, impede, and prejudice the rights and remedies of the Additional Respondent-Judgment Creditor; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Sheriff of the City of New York or the sheriff of any county within the State of New York, to whom a copy of this Order certified by the Clerk of the Court shall be delivered, shall forthwith upon the receipt thereof, and during such hours as this Court may be in session, take the body of the said Petitioners, JUDITH HERSKOWITZ, [REDACTED], or any of them, and

produce them before the Justice Presiding at IAS Part 13 of this Court, Room 252, No. 60 Centre Street, New York, N. Y., during the time when such part is in session, or if that Court is not in session or is otherwise engaged, then to the Ex Parte Motion Office, Room 315, of such court, for a hearing pursuant to §772 et seq. of the Judiciary Law, to determine whether they shall be committed to custody for contempt of Court; or for such other disposition as the Court in its discretion shall direct.
