() Assigned cases do not require an RJI.

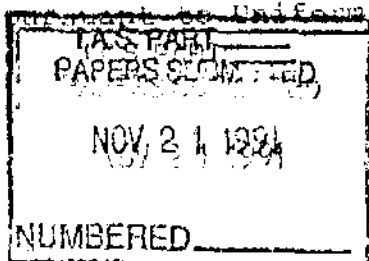
