
JUDITH HERSKOWITZ, respectfully submits her Response to the Order to Show Cause dated June 16, 2006.

Most respectfully, the Court would give the appearance of due process by that Order to Show Cause by inviting a response from Herskowitz, when the whole process is in derogation of due process where it has been prearranged that Windels cannot be opposed on his Motion for Approval of Accounting of Receiver. With that stated objective Herskowitz has been denied standing in this Court's order of March 23, 2006, on the accusation that she owes \$4 million on a turnover order of September 18, 1992. However, this has been shown to be a fiction in Herskowitz's Motion for Disqualification of Judge, which Windels has not and was not able to rebut.

Herskowitz's response is fully set forth in her Motion for Disqualification demonstrating that the Judge is disqualified. This is a matter required to be heard before any consideration of Windels' motion for approval of his accounting, that cannot be opposed because it has been predetermined to be approved ex parte. It has to be taken into consideration as to upon what basis can this Court proceed ex parte in flagrant violation of due process, where it cannot even be supported by the record that Windels is authorized to act as receiver for the assets of the North

Jersey Trading Corporation to disburse funds to his retroactively designated creditors, with no proof of claim. However, it is to be noted that would this be in reverse that I failed to abide by an order of this Court, I would be defaulted.
